

Gini was active in the community and in the Acworth United Methodist Church, where she began playing the piano years ago. Over the last several years, she greatly enjoyed singing in the choir, where she was surrounded by a close knit group of dear friends. In addition to her husband and two children, she is survived by her daughter-in-law, Susann Meadows Braden, son-in-law, Brent Robertson, and grandchildren Lindsey and Trammell Braden, and Emily and Will Robertson; her brother Robert P.
